Many church-goers are unaware that Easter is a celebration of the pagans that was adopted and instituted by the Catholic Church, and is not of Christ. In fact, Christians are told not to observe the days of pagan tradition:

Howbeit then, when ye knew not God, ye did service unto them which by nature are no gods. But now, after that ye have known God...how turn ye again to the weak and beggarly elements, whereunto ye desire again to be in bondage?

Ye observe days, and months, and times, and years. I am afraid of you, lest I have bestowed upon you labour in vain.

- Galations 4: 8-11

Paul taught the early church not to turn back to their pagan ways, but church buildings everywhere still observe Easter, which is a pagan name representing the goddess Ishtar. The goddess of the pagans is symbolized by the moon, which is why Easter each year falls on the first full moon after the Spring Equinox (Mar 21st), and is part of the sun-worship cycle heathen and witches still honor today.



Hear the word of the LORD... Your new moons and your appointed feasts my soul hateth: they are a trouble unto me; I am weary to bear them. And when ye spread forth your hands, I will hide mine eyes from you: yea, when ye make many prayers, I will not hear: your hands are full of blood. Wash you, make you clean; put away the evil of your doings from before mine eyes; cease to do evil;

-Isaiah 1:10-16

Don't let the festivities of rabbits and eggs fool you; the Lord God hates these feasts and traditions of the heathen.

Many are calling Christ "Lord," but refuse to do what He says:

And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?

- Luke 6:46

Traffic accidents, illness, and other events could take our lives at any moment, and we only have this life to repent and believe on Jesus Christ. If we do not, once this life is over, we will face judgement in God's courtroom, and eternal punishment awaits all those who have broken His Law.
